INT. BEDROOM. EVENING.

JUSTIN and STACI are laying in a bed. If there is a wall next to the bed, maybe with legs up on the wall. If not, have Staci leaning towards Justin and him looking up at her.

STACI
Can you believe it's almost been a year?

JUSTIN
The first of many right?

STACI
Don't do anything too fancy ok?

JUSTIN
Oh, well there goes the circus I booked.

They laugh.

EXT. SIDEWALK. DAYTIME.

Justin and CARL are walking down the road. Or tossing a frisbee back and forth.

CARL
So, plans for your anniversary?

JUSTIN
I have a plan.

CARL
It's more than just flowers and a card right?

JUSTIN
She doesn't want anything fancy.

CARL
You're talking about a woman here. What she says and wants are two different things.

INT. STORE.

Justin is picking out some flowers. SCOTT comes up in a bit of a hurry.

(CONTINUED)

SCOTT

Where have you been? I've been
trying to call you all day!

JUSTIN

I was getting stuff ready.

SCOTT

There's been an accident.

INT. HOSPITAL ROOM. OR A DIFFERENT BEDROOM THAN BEFORE.

Staci is in a hospital bed. Justin enters the doorway
holding flowers.

STACI

I didn't know.

Justin walks closer to the bed.

I'm so sorry.

Close up on Staci's face, she's sad, crying.

Will you still love me?

Can you still love me?

Far shot to show Justin next to the bed, and Staci in the
bed has robot parts.

Can I love?

INT. DINING ROOM.

Justin and Staci are sitting at a table to eat. Staci has
very pronounced robot arms. While Justin eats, she just sits
there sad. Her arm falls off. Justin attempts to reattach
it.

EXT. PARK. DAYTIME.

While walking together Staci abruptly stops mid step. Justin
goes and reboots her via the switch behind her ear or back
of the neck.

INT. DINING ROOM.

Justin, Staci, Scott, OTHER PERSON, are at the table playing
a game. Staci starts drooling oil. Scott and Other Person
are a bit shocked. Justin quickly cleans it up as Staci just
continues staring forward.

EXT. PARK. DAYTIME.

Staci is sitting on a bench alone. Justin comes and sits next to her.

JUSTIN

You realize you'll probably outlive me.

STACI

You're the one that's living.

JUSTIN

I still love you.

STACI

I can't have kids. I don't eat food. I'm prone to rusting. I'm wires and metal. What can you still love?

JUSTIN

It didn't change who you are. And that's the part I love the most.

Staci leans into Justin, and he holds her there in the park.
